## Draft Test Purpose

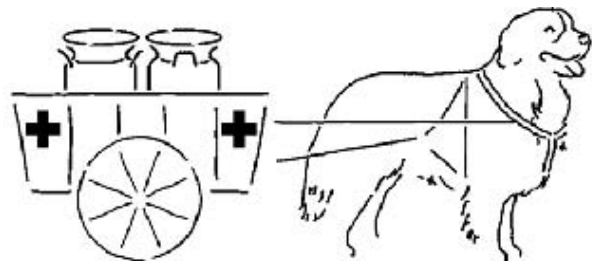

Efficiency in accomplishment of tasks is essential. It is also desirable that the dog evidence willingness and enjoyment of his work in a combination of controlled teamwork with his handler and natural independence.

## Test Site

The test site is a recreational area adjacent to a lake. There is a large grass area with an asphalt parking area. A large pavilion is located adjacent to the grassy area. Electricity is available. Running water is possible depending on weather, primitive rest rooms are also available. *All vehicles entering the park must have a valid 2010 State Park Motor Vehicle Permit properly affixed to the front windshield*; resident annual MVP costs \$24; a non-resident annual MVP costs \$29; all vehicles registered in Michigan will qualify for a resident MVP; daily resident, \$6; daily non-resident, \$8; senior annual, \$6.

Directions to site: I-94 east or west to exit 150 (Mt. Hope Rd). North on Mt. Hope to Seymour Rd. West on Seymour to the Portage Lake Unit.

**NOTE:** Please follow above directions, entering the address in your GPS will NOT get you to the test site.

## Classes Offered

- ♥ Classes offered: Novice Draft, Open Draft, Novice Brace, Open Brace.
- ♥ A separate entry form must be filled out for each dog of a brace team and then stapled together. Even though two entry forms are required for each brace team, each brace team will be counted as one entry in the Draft Test entry limit.
- ♥ If more than 20 entries are received, a random drawing will be held within 48 hours after the closing date. All entrants will be notified by email or mail of their entry status. Alternates will also be drawn and may compete in the absence of regular entries.
- ♥ Drawing preference: Untitled BMD's, Titled BMD's, Untitled non-BMD's, Titled non-BMD's

## Close of Entries

Entries close at 6:00 pm EST on October 4, 2010 at the Draft Test Secretary's address, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled or altered, except as specifically allowed in the current BMDCA Draft Test regulations. ## Regulations

Entrants are responsible for obtaining the BMDCA Draft Test Regulations (revised as of June, 2007) and being familiar with them. ### Attention Exhibitors

- ♥ Entered dogs must be 24 months old or older on the day of the Draft Test (birth date must be on or before October 16, 2008).
- ♥ Open entries must include a veterinary certificate stating the dog's name and weight. This certificate must be dated within 60 days prior to October 16, 2010.
- ♥ Handlers must provide their own rigs, harnesses, and tie downs or other means of securing a load on their particular draft rig.
- ♥ Handlers must bring their own weight (which will be weighed at the test site).
- ♥ The Draft Test Regulations specifically address refunds for bitches in season and for medical withdrawals (p 18 June 2007 edition) Vet verification must be received within 2 weeks following the test for refunds.
- ♥ Entry fees will be refunded for all alternate teams who do not receive the opportunity to participate in the test, however, if the offer to participate is made and refused the entry fee will not be refunded.
- ♥ The two dogs of a brace team need not be owned by the same person or by the handler.
- ♥ No refunds will be made for any other reasons than those in the Regulations or published in this premium.

## Awards

Each passing team will receive an award from the Heart of Michigan Bernese Mt. Dog Club. All participants will receive a certificate of participation and a ring favor.

### Refreshments & Lunch

Morning coffee, hot chocolate and baked goods will be available at the site. A buffet style picnic lunch will be available. Donations will be gratefully accepted.

### Reminder

Water and electricity will available on site (weather permitting), but you should bring water for your dogs just in case.
