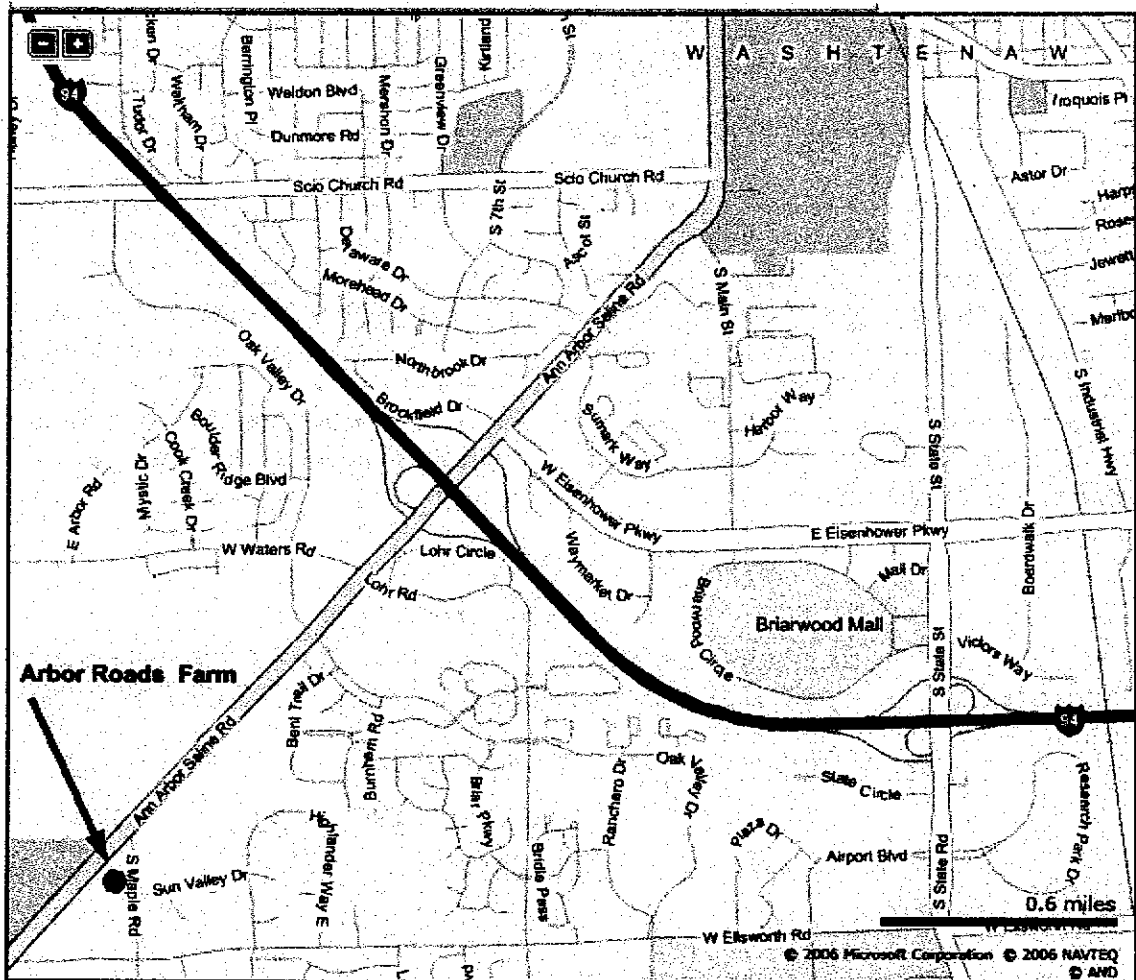
11:00 Potluck Lunch	Bring a side dish, salad or dessert to share. (Plus serving utensils, of course!) The club will provide the main dish and all tableware.

Directions

Arboroads Farm is located at 3660 S. Maple Rd. in Ann Arbor. Take I-94 to exit 175 (Saline-Ann Arbor Rd. exit). Go South about 3/4 of a mile to the light at S. Maple (you'll pass Meijer). Turn left on to S. Maple and Arboroads Farms is the second driveway on the right (only a very short distance after turning). Park by the large building.

DIRECTIONS:

From South: take 75N to 275N. Follow 275N to 8Mile Rd exit 167. Take 8Mile (West) about 12 miles to Pontiac Trail. Turn left (South) onto Pontiac Trail, follow ¼ mile to Mae Lane. Turn left (East) onto Mae Lane.

From West: take 94E to M14E exit 171. Left-hand exit. Take M14 about 5 miles to 23N (left-hand exit). Take 23N 5 miles to North Territorial Rd. Turn right (East) and follow North-T to a 4-way stop light at Pontiac Trail. Turn left (North) onto Pontiac Trail and follow about 4½ miles to Mae Lane. Turn right (East) onto Mae Lane.

From North & East: follow I96 to exit 153 Kent LK Rd. Go South on Kent LK Rd to Silver LK Rd. Turn left (East) onto Silver LK Rd follow to Pontiac Trail about 1/4mile. Turn right (South) onto Pontiac Trail, follow for 5½ miles to Mae Lane. Turn left (East) onto Mae Lane.
